... about Oregon Pregnancy Resource Centers & Medical Clinics

1. Pregnancy centers provide free, safe, confidential pregnancy counseling and medical services to more than 45,000 women in Oregon every year.
2. Pregnancy centers protect all client information with strict confidentiality.
3. Pregnancy centers always provide sonograms under the supervision of a licensed physician and performed by or in front of trained, licensed nurses or sonographers.
4. Pregnancy Centers do not seek or receive government funding.
5. Pregnancy Centers are governed by the Oregon Pregnancy Center Association (OPCA) standards of service and in addition are members and meet the standards of various national affiliation organizations.

**Oregon Pregnancy Resource Centers & Medical Clinics offer a vital safety net for women, children and families in local communities**

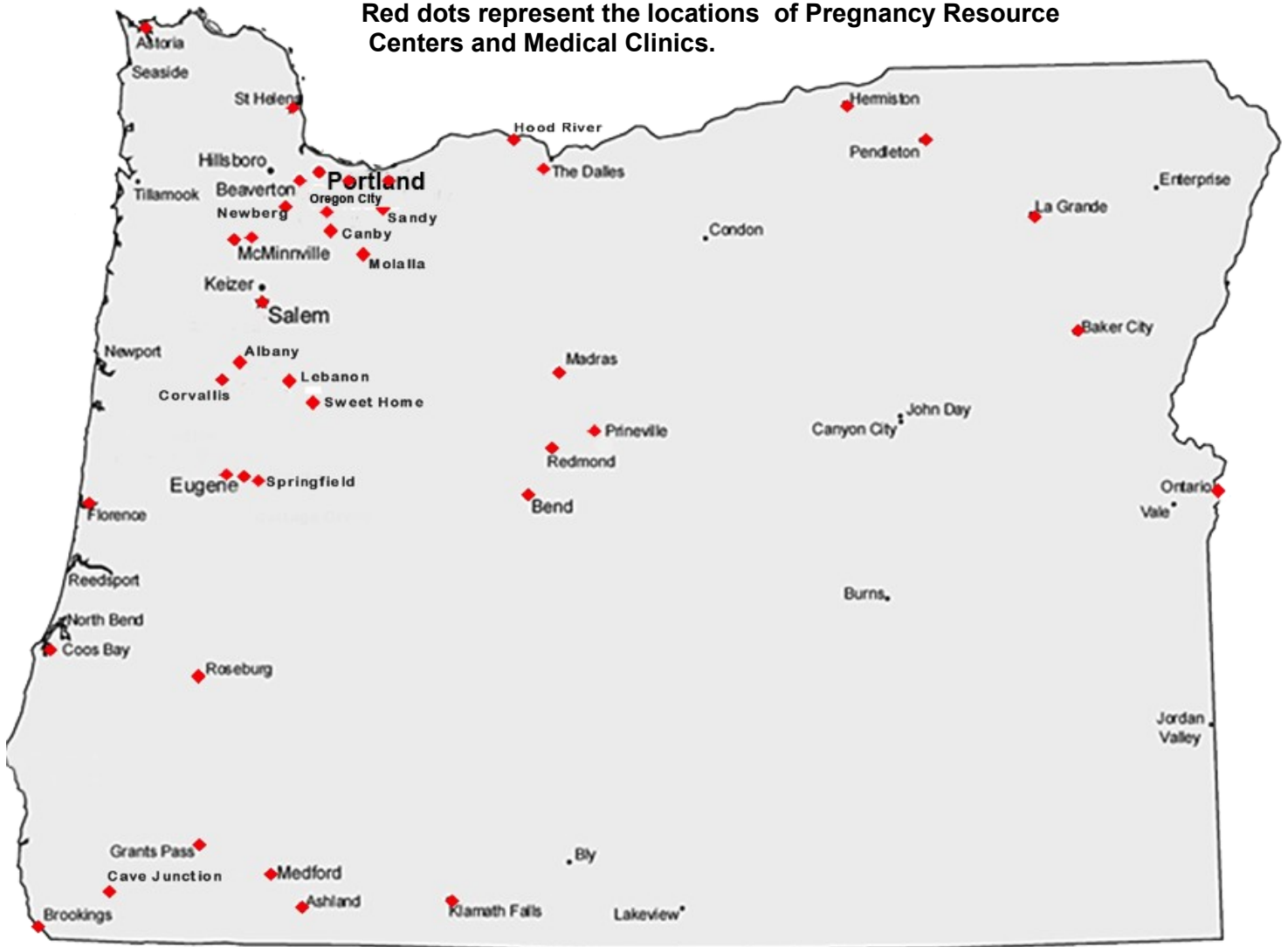
